**St Margaret of Scotland
National Pilgrimage
Sunday 3rd June**

The annual St Margaret's Pilgrimage, revived by Archbishop Cushley in 2015, after a break of 40 years, will take place in Dunfermline on 3rd June. Pilgrims can spend the day exploring the historic and religious places associated with St Margaret before gathering for the procession through the town in the afternoon. The day concludes with Holy Mass in St Margaret's Memorial Church with the overflow congregation directed to the Crypt and Carnegie Hall. This event has proved very popular over the past three years and, if wished, a coach to take parishioners from St Kentigern's, St John the Baptist's and St Joseph's Broomhouse could be booked. **BUT WE NEED TO KNOW THE LEVEL OF INTEREST VERY SOON** as coach companies will be busy in June.
